




Outbreaks of bacterial infection




In Scotland, approximately 21% of all invasive Group A Streptococcus (iGAS) reports received through Public Health Scotland's (PHS) national iGAS enhanced surveillance system indicated a risk factor of injecting drug use.

This proportion has been increasing in recent years and may be **linked to a rise in stimulant use**.




Drug Related Deaths (Scotland) 2014-2022





Cocaine transportation - seizure


