

- Families : The Blocks 1,2 supporting workbook – Fatima was me city




The Blocks : Fatima Dublin

Family Support RCDT


FamilyWorks a systemic family therapy model and approach involving all members of the family as a resource for wisdom ,change and healing.

- Committee held further engagements with stakeholders June October 2024
- From these engagements 59 recommendations were made in the interim report of 2024
- Committee runs until January 2025
